- Control energy-related operations to maximise the appropriate use of renewable energy sources, lower overall energy consumption, and improve energy efficiency.
- Follow the requirements of all applicable energy laws, standards of conduct, and compliance requirements.
- Create a structure with this policy for establishing, evaluating, and revisiting its energy aims and objectives on a regular basis.
- Make sure that the resources required for achieving the objectives are allocated.
- Create energy performance metrics and a well-defined reporting framework with assigned roles.
- Encourage employees to become conscious of the company's impact by giving them relevant information about its emissions and energy usage, as well as any efforts it makes to improve.
- When designing a project or choosing equipment, keep energy efficiency in mind. You should also encourage the procurement of energy-efficient goods and services.
- As appropriate, the Energy Policy will be distributed to all staff members and interested parties. Periodically, the policy will be reviewed and changed if needed.
